About the Educational Futures and Student Success Task Force

The Educational Futures and Student Success Task Force is charged with developing a vision and strategic plan for meeting the needs of the growing and diversifying student population in the state of Utah.

The task force is exploring innovative ways to accommodate growth at the University of Utah to approximately 40,000 students, respond to workforce needs and raise the intellectual and cultural profile of the university while maintaining the highest quality education.

Growth for the sake of growth is not the objective; rather, it is to uphold the U's responsibility to educate Utahns, ensure the success of an ever more diverse set of students, respond to economic needs and raise the intellectual and cultural profile of the university. In short, it is about the educational, academic and intellectual future of the campus.

The task force will aim to provide an initial report in April, with a mid-term report in September and final report in December.

Some of the goals the task force will address include:

- Increasing six-year graduation rates
- Increasing student and faculty diversity
- Producing 2,500 STEM degree graduates and an additional 6,000 graduates in high demand areas to meet workforce needs
- Expanding the university's online course offerings
- Exploring innovative options to reduce student costs
